WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues or planned to be expended from reserves/fund balances so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of directors of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8, Grand County, Colorado:

- Section 1. That the budget as submitted, amended, and summarized by fund, hereby is approved and adopted as the budget of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 for the year stated above.
- Section 2. That the budget hereby approved and adopted shall be certified by any officer or the District Administrator of the District and made a part of the public records of the District.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on October 30, 2019 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses and capital expenditure purposes from property tax revenue is \$26,711.20 and;

WHEREAS, the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 finds that it is required to temporarily lower the general operating mill levy to render a refund for 0.00, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for contractual obligations approved at election is \$0.00 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for capital expenditure purposes from property tax revenue approved by voters or at public hearing is \$0.00, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for voter approved bonds and interest is \$0.00, and;

WHEREAS, the 2019 valuation for assessment for the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8, as certified by the County Assessor is \$1,335,560

- Section 3. That for the purpose of meeting the contractual obligations of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 during the 2020 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2019.

That for the purpose of meeting all payments for bonds and interest of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 during the 2020 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2019.
- Section 6.
