Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 will receive advances from the master developer with the funding being used for payment of general administrative costs.

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues or planned to be expended from reserves/fund balances so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of directors of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8, Grand County, Colorado:

- Section 1. That the budget as submitted, amended, and summarized by fund, hereby is approved and adopted as the budget of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 for the year stated above.
- Section 2. That the budget hereby approved and adopted shall be certified by any officer or the District Administrator of the District and made a part of the public records of the District.

#### TO SET MILL LEVIES

A RESOLUTION LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2017, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE GRANBY RANCH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 8, GRAND COUNTY, COLORADO, FOR THE 2018 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on November 30, 2017 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses and capital expenditure purposes from property tax revenue is \$0.00 and;

WHEREAS, the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 finds that it is required to temporarily lower the general operating mill levy to render a refund for \$0.00, and;

- Section 2. That for the purposes of rendering a refund to its constituents during budget year 2018 there is hereby levied a temporary tax credit/mill levy reduction of 0.000 mills.
- Section 3. That for the purpose of meeting the contractual obligations of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 during the 2018 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2017.

- Section 4. That for the purpose of meeting all capital expenditures of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 during the 2018 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.00 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2017.
- Section 5. That for the purpose of meeting all payments for bonds and interest of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 during the 2018 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2017.
- Section 6. That any officer or the District Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to either immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Grand County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 as hereinabove determined and set, or be authorized and directed to certify to the County Commissioners of Grand County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 as hereinabove determined and set based upon the final (December) certification of valuation from the county assessor.
