The District was established to plan for, design, acquire, construct, install, relocate, redevelop, finance, operate and maintain certain public Improvements including but not limited to streets, water, parks & recreation, safety protection, sanitary sewer, and mosquito control.

The District has no employees and all operations and administrative functions are contracted.

The following budget is prepared on the modified accrual basis of accounting, which is consistent with the basis of accounting used in presenting the District's financial statements.

#### 2016 BUDGET STRATEGY

Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 was formed in 2008 and contracts with Headwaters Metropolitan District which provides the "coordinating" district responsible for managing the construction, acquisition and operation of public facilities and improvements needed to serve the Granby Ranch project area. Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 will not assess property taxes during 2016. Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 will obtain its funding in 2016 from inter-district contributions from Headwaters Metropolitan District, with the funding being used primarily for payment of general administrative costs.

- Section 1. That the budget as submitted, amended, and summarized by fund, hereby is approved and adopted as the budget of the Granby Ranch Metropolitan District No. 8 for the year stated above.
- Section 2. That the budget hereby approved and adopted shall be certified by any officer or the District Administrator of the District and made a part of the public records of the District.
